GENERAL INFORMATION

1. QUALIFICATIONS:

- a. Top 15% of Junior Class is invited to complete the Senior Salute application. Up to 20 students will be selected at the discretion of the Senior Salute selection committee.
- b. Applicants must have taken College Prep or Accelerated English since grade nine.

NOTE: Any student, once selected for senior salute, who is suspended from school for any reason, will have their picture removed immediately from the board and name removed from any designation with Senior Salute.

2. This application must be returned to the counselor's office by 3:30 pm, Friday, April 27, 2018. APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THIS TIME WILL BE INELIGIBLE FOR REVIEW. THE SENIOR SALUTE CHAIRPERSON WILL PICK UP THE APPLICATIONS AT THIS TIME TO START THE VERIFICATION OF THE INFORMATION ON EACH APPLICATION.

3. Students will be notified by mail of the decision by the Selection Committee. Letters will be mailed no later than May 18, 2018.

- a. Lee Gibbs will be the Senior Salute photographer. Photographs will be taken in June. Scheduling information will accompany the letters to the applicants chosen by the Selection committee.

4. INSTRUCTIONS:

- a. When completing this application, be careful to fill in all columns with requested information for each item you list.
- b. Application should be typed (no hand-written applications will be accepted).
- c. You may attach additional pages if more space is needed. Make sure you carry all headings forward and designate them as continued.
- d. Include only those activities in which you have participated during grades 9, 10 & 11.
- e. Do not abbreviate clubs, activities, etc.
- f. It is the responsibility of the applicant to secure all verifications in writing. Phone calls will not be accepted.
- g. This is a very comprehensive application. Allow yourself plenty of time to acquire the verification signatures.
